**Preface :**

## **Part A :**

**The chalked out plan of Action by IQAC (in the beginning of the year) towards quality enhancement and outcome is successfully achieved by the end of the year.**

The institute has finalised the plan of action at the beginning of the year taking into consideration the suggestions /improvement measures as suggested by NAAC: Seven point criteria of NACC for re-accreditation, proper planning for allround development of tribal, rural and other students, gender initiatives for girl students and motivation of students.

To fulfill the objectives framed by IQAC through continuous efforts, quality sustenance and enhancement activities were conducted throughout the year by various committees constituted at our college level. Our institute being in the region of tribal inhabitants, we have considerable number of tribal students, approximately 65% of tribal and rural strength of the college.

**a) From the various suggestions made by Peer Team, The following suggestions were taken into consideration for improvement during this academic year**

- 1) Increased infrastructure facilities
- 2) Continuous efforts for quality sustenance and enhancement
- 3) Utilized various research grants
- 4) More programmes are organized for allround personality development of tribal and rural students.
- 5) More participation of students in general and students council in particular.
- 6) Gender Positive initiatives for girl students such as 'Yuwati Sabha' and 'Women Counsellor'.

### **Achievements :**

The institute follows the principle of action with "planning makes the work perfect." From the above mentioned statement, we can say firmly that, we have achieved a lot. This become more evident when one goes through the criteria wise information in part B of this Report.

- 1) Our college has received a grant of 9,46,000/- rupees towards college development scheme from university Grants commission, which is supposed to be utilized for the

development of various laboratories and the infrastructural facilities.

- 2) For quality sustenance and enhancement guided by NAAC we have established an IQAC committee in the College. The principal is the chairman of the IQAC with a Co-ordinator and a team of IQAC members have held meetings at various levels such as staff meeting, meeting of Heads of Department and the meetings of IQAC committee members during this academic year.
- 3) Applications of the teaching staff members have been forwarded to various funding agencies to obtain grants for major and minor research papers. This is further elaborated in part B of this report.
- 4) More programmes for allround personality development of students have been arranged for which the institute has established various college committees. These committees have been given in the appendix at the end of this report.

The Yuwati Sabha has motivated the girl students to participate in the various college activities. Special programmes were organized by the committee throughout the year which is clearly mentioned in detail in criteria-wise report of part-B.

6) All heads of department have observed that academic activities are completed in time during the academic year. The suggestions of students council are welcomed for academic programmes and in the college administration to achieve the goal of our institute our qualified staff and experienced teachers worked in that directions. Chairman of Board of Studies, Members of Faculty, Senate Members, etc. They take an active part in the academic activities of the University. Moreover some of our teachers have linkage with the society and community, who are playing active role in the society. This is guiding example of social services of our teachers.

## **Part - B**

### **1] Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution :**

The goal of the institution is to empower the tribal and rural students through higher education'. The college conducts various activities to bring the tribal and rural students in the main stream of higher education. All activities are planned to make the all round development of the students. Our college encourage the students to take part in various activities and events to achieve the goal of all round development of the students. In Gandhian thought examination 148 students have appeared. Out of them, Arun Rama Pawar stood second in the district. In the orientation course of one day 15 boys and 08 girls have participated in 'Eklavya Training Centre' Nandurbar While 02 girls and 02 boys have participated in persohality and leadership camp organised at shirpur college.

Our N.C.C. unit is also active in promoting the N.C.C. cadets to take part in various activities, 25 N.C.C. cadets of our unit have participated in the 'Avhan 2010' Camp, Organised at Kalina Camp of Mumbai, during 22nd Dec. 2010 to 1st Jan. 2011 Out of them our cadet Priyank Shah stood first, in the first Aid Competition.

### **2] New academic programmes initiated :**

The college has a facility of "Virtual Learning Centre" (VLC) which is started for guidance of competitive examinations to the students such as MPSC, UPSC and the M.A. Sociology course of the VCMOU has also been started through VLC in our college.

### **3] Innovations in curricular design and transition :**

The curriculam has been changed for the second year graduate classes of Arts, Science and Commerce from June 2010. The semester system has been introduce for second year of all the three faculties, in which 40 marks for the university examinations and 10 marks for internal assessment for each course in each semester.

### **4] Inter Disciplinary Programmes started :**

The inter disciplinary programme of environmental studies was started from June 2004 for the First year classes of all faculties which is continued in the present year also, The second inter disciplinary programme of a general knowledge course for the second year classes of all faculties is also continued in the present year also.

### **5] Examination reforms implemented :**

The semester system for the First year classes was started in the last academic year 2009 -10 This semester pattern has been started for second year classes from this

academic year 2010 -11 In which 10marks for each course are reserved for an internal assessment while the university examination well be for 40marks each course.The semester pattern is scheduled to be started for the third year of all faculties from the next academic year.
